



12 Local Museums to Participate in an All Virtual Butte County Museum Weekend February 27 & 28

BUTTE COUNTY, Calif. (February 22, 2021) – In an effort to keep the community safe during the COVID-19 pandemic, the local museum community is proud to present a fun and free Butte County Museum Weekend virtual event February 27 & 28, 2021. With coordinating led by Explore Butte County (EBC), 12 local museums (and counting!) are participating in the engaging effort by offering digital, virtual and/or social activations for the community to experience and enjoy from the comfort of home. The all-virtual Butte County Museum Weekend is being held in lieu of the annual Free Museum Weekend, a new event that was started in 2020.

Butte County Museum Weekend is in alignment with the goal to provide all members of the community access to experience the region's incredible wealth of art, history, and science. The Museum Weekend landing page and coordination allows the public to view a sampling of the offerings available from local museums, all in one place. While many of the offerings may be pre-recorded virtual tours, a handful of the participating museums are offering scheduled demonstrations during the weekend and may require pre-registration (activations requiring registration can be found at the top of the event landing page). As one example, Valene L. Smith Museum of Anthropology is partnering with artist Kim Cobb to present "Recipes Tell Our Stories," a live art workshop on Saturday at 11 a.m. to make recipe cards and create a community cookbook.

"We're thrilled to identify new and exciting ways to connect with the community during a 'reimagined' Butte County Museum Weekend," said Explore Butte County executive director, Carolyn Denero. "We hope the virtual activations provided by participating museums serve to remind the community about the wealth of enriching experiences our regional museums will have to offer once we are able to welcome everyone back."
