

A Fabulous Fall Destination, Explore Butte County Partners with Sierra Oro Farm Trail & Encourages Visitation to the North State

BUTTE COUNTY, Calif. (September 6, 2022) – In October, Explore Butte County is proud to once again partner with the Sierra Oro Farm Trail to promote the month-long mobile Farm & Wine Pass, available as part of the local farming community's annual harvest celebration. The mobile tasting pass offers admission to more than 30 Butte County farms and wineries, opening the door to world-class specialty food destinations throughout the region.

"The Sierra Oro Farm Trail offers a wonderful opportunity for people to visit our farms and wineries to learn about where their food comes from, meet local farmers and makers, and enjoy a taste of our region in a fun and welcoming way," said Explore Butte County's Carolyn Denero.

Visitors to the area undoubtedly notice an impressive number of field and tree crops as they travel throughout the agriculture-rich region. According to the 2020 Butte County Crop Report, more than 110,000 acres are orchard crops with walnuts and almonds topping the acreage count followed by pistachios, chestnuts, and kiwi that are also grown in the local area. Field crops make up more than 270,000 acres in Butte County, with rice comprising the largest category grown in the fields. In all, the estimated gross value of agricultural production in Butte County totaled a whopping \$625,384,709 in 2020 alone.

Always an amazing agricultural destination for those hungry for a culinary adventure, Butte County in fall is an exciting time to visit and explore for many other reasons, too, including its wide-open spaces, hiking, and biking trails, prized waterways, special community events, and much more.

"We hope the easy-to-use Farm & Wine Pass is the starting point for new enthusiasts looking for a fun road trip to explore the bounty and beauty of Butte County that has so many other adventures to offer as well," said Denero.
