BUTTE COUNTY, Calif. (February 2, 2022) – The North State museum community is proud to participate in the 3rd annual Butte County Museum Weekend presented by Explore Butte County. This year's event will take place on February 26 & 27. More than 15 local museums, galleries and cultural centers will offer free admission from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. for the in-person event, with each showcasing a new exhibit or extra offering for the weekend. The free annual event had its start in 2020 just prior to the pandemic and the group has been working hard to ensure the event continues into the future. The real goal is to provide all members of the community access to the region's incredible abundance of art, history, and science.

"We are thrilled to continue offering Butte County Museum Weekend each year so we can help raise awareness for our cherished local museums, galleries, and cultural centers," said Explore Butte County CEO, Carolyn Denero. "The special weekend serves as a reminder for everyone to explore the wealth of enriching experiences our regional museums have to offer.
